Camp

Time: Church Friday at 2:30 to leave (we are going to central time)

What To Bring:

This is a list of items needed by each camper. It is not intended to be restrictive (a list of prohibited items is found below). There is no excess storage space at camp and the securing of valuables is impossible. Each camper will be responsible for his/ her own property.

Bedding:

- Twin Sheets – 1 fitted and 1 loose
- One Blanket
- One Pillow with pillowcase
- A Sleeping bag if you do not want to use sheets

Equipment:

- Bible
- Pencil/pen and notebook if you want to keep a camp journal
- Flashlight and spare batteries
- **Plastic drink cup or bottle with your name on it**
- A personal fan for in the cabin if you choose to have one
- Clothing: (for 4 days – Friday through Monday)
 - Shirts and Shorts to play in during the day
 - (assume that they might get dirty)
 - **SHOES (DON'T JUST BRING SANDALS!!)**
 - Sleep Clothes
 - Underwear and Socks
 - Jeans if you want to wear them
 - Bathing Suit (tanktop/shirts and shorts. NO WHITE shirts)
 - Shower Shoes (flip-flops or sandals)
 - Rain Clothes

Toiletry Articles:

- Toothbrush and Toothpaste
- Shaving Equipment if needed
- Cosmetics and Hair Care Items
- Soap, Shampoo, and Deodorant
- Insect repellent and spray for cabin
- Towels and Wash Cloths
- Dirty Laundry Bag
- Special Medication as needed

THINGS NOT TO BRING:

This is a list of items that are not necessary to bring to Camp. Some are dangerous and others simply distract from the emphasis of our Camp.

- Radios, CD players, MP3 players/iPods, DVD players, and Video Games
- Magazines and books that are not for Spiritual Growth
- Tobacco of any kind, Alcohol, Illegal Drugs
- Valuables
- Fireworks
- Weapons (i.e. Knives, Guns, etc.)
- Excessive Jewelry/valuables

THE CELL PHONE RULE:

Phones are a part of our lives, you talk on them, text, take selfies, and look at your Bible app. We get that, but phones can be a huge distraction to relationship building and bringing drama from home to Camp. So this is the rule. Phone stay IN the cabin as much as possible. If you use it as a camera, then you need to only have it out for pictures. Excessive “nose in the phone” position outside of the cabin because of texting and/or social media will result in the youth ministry staff having a fun new phone to post selfies on all week.
